Discover America's Garden Capital

Longwood Gardens is the world's premier horticulture display garden. Longwood features 20 indoor gardens and 20 outdoor gardens, both featuring breathtaking seasonal displays. View rainbow rows



of tulips in spring, massive thousand-bloom mums in the fall, and illuminated fountain shows during the summer Festival of Fountains.

The 2021 Philadelphia Flower Show, the nation's largest horticultural event, is closer than ever to the Brandywine Valley. This year's outdoor event will take place in FDR Park June 5– June 13, 2021.

Explore all the gardens of the du Pont family legacy:

- Hagley Museum and Library, where the du Pont's fascinating story begins, is set along the Brandywine River on 235 scenic acres.
- <u>Nemours Mansion and Garden</u>, the countryside estate of Alfred I. du Pont, was built in late 18th-century French style with breathtaking gold statues.
- <u>Winterthur Museum, Garden & Library</u>, founded by Henry Francis du Pont, is the premier museum of American decorative arts featuring a 60-acre naturalistic garden.

- Enjoy group tastings throughout the region's beautiful countryside wineries and vineyards, including <u>Chaddsford Winery</u>.
- Discover the passionate craft brewing tradition of the region at one of 20 local breweries in the <u>BVBrewScene</u>, including <u>Victory Brewery</u> and <u>Levante Brewing</u>.
- Celebrate the Mushroom Capital of the World with a visit to <u>The Woodlands at Phillips</u> <u>Mushroom Farms</u>, or mark your calendar for the annual <u>Kennett Square Mushroom Festival</u>, held the weekend after Labor Day.
- See how the county's most beloved salty snacks are made at Herr's Snack Factory.
- Choose from an eclectic variety of <u>local dining</u> <u>options</u> unique to the Brandywine Valley, from farm-fresh to fine dining.

- Visit the Brandywine River Museum of Art to experience three generations of Wyeth family art housed in a towering historic grist mill. Enjoy lunch at the museum's Millstone Café and stroll beautiful outdoor paths lining the Brandywine River.
